2024 WT Services, Inc. Scholarship Application

Rules and Requirements

WT Services, Inc. will award scholarships to be disbursed in 50% increments per semester. Scholarship recipients will be announced in May, 2024. High school seniors in Hereford, Friona, Bovina, and Bushland who will graduate this spring, high school graduates, and GED holders from these communities are eligible for the scholarships, subject to the following requirements:

1. Your parents or guardians must be customers of WT SERVICES in Hereford, Friona, Bovina, or Bushland, or you must be a WT SERVICES customer in these communities yourself. The WT SERVICES scholarship may be used at any state or churchsponsored college or university, or at any accredited vocational or technical school.

2. Your application form must be accompanied by two letters of recommendation, and a wallet-size photo. Do not submit computer photos on plain paper. One letter must be from a teacher, principal, or counselor from the high school that you are attending or graduated from, or that issued your GED. If you have been out of high school a number of years, you may obtain a letter from a college or trade school instructor or counselor. You must be graduating from high school this spring, have graduated high school, or have completed your GED in order to be eligible.

3. Your application must be fully completed, typed or legibly printed, have no attachments other than the photo and letters of recommendation, and MUST BE RE-CEIVED AT THE OFFICES OF WT SERVICES, INC. P.O. BOX 1776 (physical location 3429South U.S. Highway 385) HEREFORD, TEXAS 79045, NO LATER THAN APRIL 8, 2024. You may be asked to attend an interview at the discretion of the WT Services board of directors.

4. Recipients must maintain a minimum of 12 earned/credited hours throughout each semester, or have full-time student status at vocational or trade schools. A copy of grades will be required at the end of each semester to verify maintenance of a minimum 12 hours per semester. Grades should be sent to Scholarship Administrator, WT Services, Inc., P.O. Box 1776 Hereford, TX 79045. Failure to comply with grade reporting and a minimum 12 earned/credited hours requirements per semester means forfeiture of the following semester's payment. Recipients must provide proof of enrollment or preenrollment. Should a recipient drop out of school for any reason, the unused portion of the scholarship will be rescinded. Scholarship funds must be used within one year unless prior arrangements are made. If class scheduling conflicts create a problem, please notify the Scholarship Administrator.
